- Note Regulation 7 Agricultural and Horticultural Produce must be grown by Exhibitor.
- Entry fees to be paid at the Secretary's Office or to Stewards.
- Exhibits to be brought to the pavilion between 2pm and 7.30 pm on Thursday 7th May 2026.
- Exhibits will not be accepted on Friday morning.
- Exhibits that are to be named must be named by exhibitor on a plain label attached to exhibit or will be disqualified by judge or stewards.
- Vegetables to be displayed on foam plates supplied by show society.
- Green Bundles to be not less than 5cm in diameter, to be tied securely with two or more pieces of string or zip ties
- Grain to be in own container.
- Judging to commence at 9:30am on Friday 8th May 2026.
- Exhibits can be collected at 4:30 pm on Saturday 9th May 2026.
- All prize money must be claimed from the secretary's office before 5pm Saturday.
- The secretary's office will close at 6pm Saturday evening 9th May 2026
