- POSTED EXIBITS/ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Judging will commence at 12.30 pm Thursday 7th May 2026.
- Only Stewards to be present during judging.
- Only Stewards to remove exhibits from the displays.
- Prize money must be claimed from the Secretary's office before 5pm Saturday 9th May 2026.
- The Secretary's office will close at 5pm Saturday evening 9th May 2026.
- Needlework Section will close down at 4.30 p.m. on Saturday 9th May 2026.
- Exhibitors are required to sign when collecting their exhibits between 5 pm and 6 pm Saturday 9th May 2026.
- Uncollected exhibits will be available for collection from the Show Office on Sunday 10th May 2026.
- No exhibits can be collected before 5 pm on Saturday 9th May 2026.
- Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and **HAVE NOT BEEN SHOWN AT A PREVIOUS CROWS NEST SHOW.**
- All entries must be in clean condition – Old and soiled exhibits will not be accepted.
- An article is something not worn – a garment is something worn – an item can be either.
- Please make sure finishing off is complete - no hanging threads.
- Stewards and Judges reserve the right to transfer entries into the appropriate Class and Section if not pertaining to Needlework and Handicraft.
- All exhibits displayed are at Stewards Discretion
- Highly Commended cards will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.

HOW TO ENTER SECTIONS ONLINE

1. Create a new account or login to your existing account
 - If you have forgotten your password, please use the forgotten password feature.
2. Select CROWS NEST SHOW
3. Click on PLACE AN ENTRY
4. Click on INDIVIDUAL ENTRY
5. In Entrant Name select your Entrant from the drop down or click on ADD NEW to add a new entrant to your account
 - a. If clicking Add New fill out your Entrants name. Other fields are optional
6. In EXHIBIT TYPE select INDOOR / DISPLAY
7. Click on SELECT CLASSES
8. From the drop down choose the Section you would like to enter
9. On the pop up TICK the box to accept the entry notes and conditions for this section
10. Click the PLUS symbol beside the section you are entering to expand to the classes
11. Click on the class or classes you are entering to select them
12. If entering multiple items into the same class, increase the QTY counter to reflect the number you would like to enter
13. Fill out the items name in the Exhibition Name box if applicable eg painting name
14. Fill in any additional information the show may require for this entry if asked
15. Once all classes have been selected
16. Click on ADD ANOTHER ENTRY if you need to place more entries for this show and repeat this process
17. Click on FINISHED ADDING CLASSES if you do not need to place any more entries for this show
18. Click on FINISHED ADDING EXTRAS once done
19. Tick the box to agree to our website T&C's
20. Click **PAY** – even if you are paying cash
21. You will now be emailed an acknowledgement of your entries. Please check you Junk / Spam folder if this email is not in your inbox.
