
This award is for the highest scoring young participant across prime young judges, stud young judges and young paraders. Participants must be under the age of 25 years.

Age of Competitors

PLEASE NOTE NO LED CATTLE CLASSES / COMPETITIONS FOR 2024, BACK IN 2025

- 1.1 Competitors must be aged between 15 years of age and under 25 years as at the 1st May in the year of the State Finals.
- 1.2 Competitors under the age of 18 years must have the approval of a parent or guardian to compete and the appropriate waiver signed on the nomination form.
- 1.3 Different age classes may be added to programs at local show level. These classes will not be recognised at **Sub Chamber** or **State Finals**.

Competition Rules Cattle (Stud, Prime & Dairy) Young Judges & Paraders (As per QLD Ag Shows website)

Parader Competitions Special Rules

- 4.1 Paraders will parade their animals in a clockwise manner as is normal in a Cattle Judging Ring at the discretion of the Judge.
- 4.2 No glitter is permissible on animals or paraders. Cattle are to be presented in their natural, clean state.
- 4.3 Stud Beef Paraders must wear a white dust coat and not display any name or logo at the Steward's discretion.
- 4.4 Paraders will not wear lace up footwear to parade any animal to ensure compliance with workplace health and safety regulations.
- 4.5 Beef Cattle Paraders may lead a Steer, Heifer or Bull under 20 months.

Conditions of Entry:

- There will be two classes, under 15 years and 15—25 years.
- There must be a minimum of 6 competitors in the class or the judging of that class will not proceed.
- For each class no less than four animals of a prescribed beef cattle breed will be provided.
- Each competitor will be provided with a card on which he/she will place the animals in order of merit and give reasons for doing so. Upon completing the card, it will be handed to the steward of that section for presentation to the judge, who may, if he/she desires, question the competitor on any points in his/her judgement, or any feature in connection with the cattle being judged.
- In making his/her awards, the judge shall take into consideration the correctness of picking of the animals and the reasons given
- No entry fee is required, but entry subject to approval of the Show Committee.
- Competition will take place on Saturday following the Stud Beef judging.

The Society will arrange for a competent person to demonstrate the points of the breed and explain their purpose in the general scheme of animal husbandry immediately after the cards are handed in.

Young Judges Competition Special Rules

- 5.2 In all competitions four (4) exhibits NUMBER 1, 2 3 and 4 are to be used to suit the scoring from the Hormel Slide.
- 5.3 Where possible competitions should have the following classes:
- (a) Stud Beef 3 classes to be used (e.g. British, Tropical, European)
- (b) Prime Beef 3 classes to be used (e.g. Jap Ox, Korean, Local Trade, etc.)
- (c) Dairy Cattle 3 classes to be used (e.g. A.Q, Friesian, Jersey, etc)
